## CREATING YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

#### Create your page and personalise it



Create your page on your chosen fundraising platform. We recommend JustGiving, see the instructions below. Tell your story! Tell people why you're taking on this challenge and why SIFA Fireside is important to you. The more people connect with your challenge, the more likely they are to donate. Set a fundraising target: pages with a target raise an average of 46% more!

#### Share it far and wide

Start with friends and family: share your fundraising page link in texts and emails amongst people you know. Share on your socials: share the link to your page on whatever social platforms you use and tag us so we can share too! Boost your fundraising at work: link to your page on your email footer (check it's allowed!), ask about match giving, plan a work challenge to encourage colleagues to donate. Reach new audiences: share your page with community groups or clubs that you are a part of, consider contacting local news outlets to spread the word!



#### Collect donations and provide updates



Now your donations are rolling in, don't forget to provide updates to your donors and followers. You might feel like you're oversharing but most people donate after seeing at least three posts. Photos and videos are key! Provide updates directly to your fundraising page or post on your socials and add the link to your page. Don't forget to thank your donors: this also gives you another opportunity to link to your fundraising page without asking for donations.

#### Don't underestimate last minute givers

Up to 20% of donations could come in after the event. Post on the day of the event to remind everyone it's happening and thank them for all their support. After the event: don't forget to tell everyone how it went (with some final photos or videos) and that there's still time to make those last minute donations!


If you can, please use JustGiving for your fundraiser!


It takes a lot of administration to manage multiple fundraising platforms. JustGiving is our chosen platform because it automatically syncs new fundraising pages with our database and donations are received automatically into our account with zero admin required!

6. Set your target! Be ambitious! (Don't forget to check about Match Funding with your employer)


7. Personalise your page - there's some text to get you started. Describe why SIFA Fireside is important to you!

8. Add a photo and publish your page!



FUNDRAISING TIPS

Keep your supporters updated! Share when things are challenging too so people understand your journey and can offer support. Tag us where you can so we can share too!











Tie in festive seasons with your fundraising activities! Have a Burn's Night dinner party, organise an Easter treasure hunt, hold a pumpkin carving competition, offer a Christmas wrapping service, be creative and ask people to donate in return!







Use your hobbies! Offer paintings, caricatures, cakes, jewellery, Origami cranes whatever you do best - in return for a donation.





Hold a games or quiz night: agree an entry donation or a donation based on scores! Snacks and leaderboard required!



#### Video content

Don't underestimate the power of video. Posts with video content are 6x more likely to result in a donation! You don't need a feature film, just a short clip with an update is all it takes!

Ask people to donate £2 to add a song to your challenge or training playlist. Raise extra funds and give yourself a boost when the song comes on; a reminder of all the people supporting you!



Contact us for a fundraising letter and see if a local business could provide you with a raffle prize for extra donations. Add a raffle to your games/quiz night to really boost your donations! See details below regarding raffles.



Rally some friends and organise a car boot sale or set up an ebay or vinted store to raise some extra funds and clear out your drawers!







#### **Self employed?**

How about adding an optional donation to your invoices?



#### **Match** giving

Lots of employers can 'match' however much you raise. This can be £ for £ and potentially double your total with very little work! Ask your employer if match giving is available and what you need to do to submit a claim.



Make sure anything you post includes the link to your fundraising page!

## USEFUL INFORMATION



#### **Charity number**

So everyone knows where their donations are going, please make sure any posters or information about your event includes the following:

"SIFA Fireside is a registered charity in England and Wales (1049728)". Not the catchiest, but very important!

If your event is in a public place, you must get permission first, from the local authority or property owner. It's a good idea to get the permission in writing for your records.

#### **Permission**



#### Insurance

Depending on your event, you might need insurance. If your event involves the general public, it's important to have Public Liability insurance. Your venue may already have insurance that would cover your event, so check with them first. If your event is at home or on private property, check your insurance covers this.



Serving up delicious treats at your event? Although you don't need approval or certificates to prepare and serve food, make sure you follow the guidelines at www.food.gov.uk to make sure any food is safe for people to eat.

#### **Public collections**

If you are planning on collecting donations in a public place (e.g. on the street), you will need a licence and an authorisation letter from us. Please contact us so we can help. You can email us at fundraising@sifafireside.co.uk or call 0121 766 1700, Monday - Friday 9am-5pm.

Raffles are a really great way to boost your fundraising efforts. To keep things simple and legal, just remember to:

- 1) ONLY sell raffles at the event, NOT before the event or offsite/online
- 2) Provide physical tickets to those who enter the raffle

You can announce the result at the event **OR** after it has ended, just let people know when. Find out full details <u>here</u>.

#### Gift Aid: boost your donation by 25p for every £1 you donate, at no extra cost to you
